Dear Friends:

Alter the CCCAN Congress in El Salvador as part of the CCCAN Championships-2007 and after receiving recommendations from the CCCAN Water Polo and Synchronized Swimming; the Executive Committee of this Confederation is approving the following changes to the CCCAN events commencing next year 2008:

**°WATER POLO (MALE and FEMALE ) CISC and CAMEX CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Group 1 : 15 years old or less at December 31<sup>st</sup> of the competition year.

Group 2 : 17 years old or less at December 31<sup>st</sup> of the competition year.

Group 3 : 18 years old or more at December 31<sup>st</sup> of the competition year.

**°WATER POLO ( MALE and FEMALE ) CCCAN CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Group 1 : 16 years old less at December 31<sup>st</sup> of the competition year.

Group 2 : 18 years old or less at December 31<sup>st</sup> of the competition year.

Group 3 : 19 years old or more at December 31<sup>st</sup> of the competition year.

**Note:** Each country could enter **not less** than 9 players and no more than 13 players.

**°SYNCHRONIZED SWIMMING – ALL CCCAN EVENTS**

-The Combination Routine event is eliminated and it is added the 19-21 years old Category at December 31<sup>st</sup> of the competition year.

-The following points table will be used: 24 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place in Solo; 36 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place in duet and 72 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place in teams.

- Awards for the Figures and Free Routine will be separated for each one.
